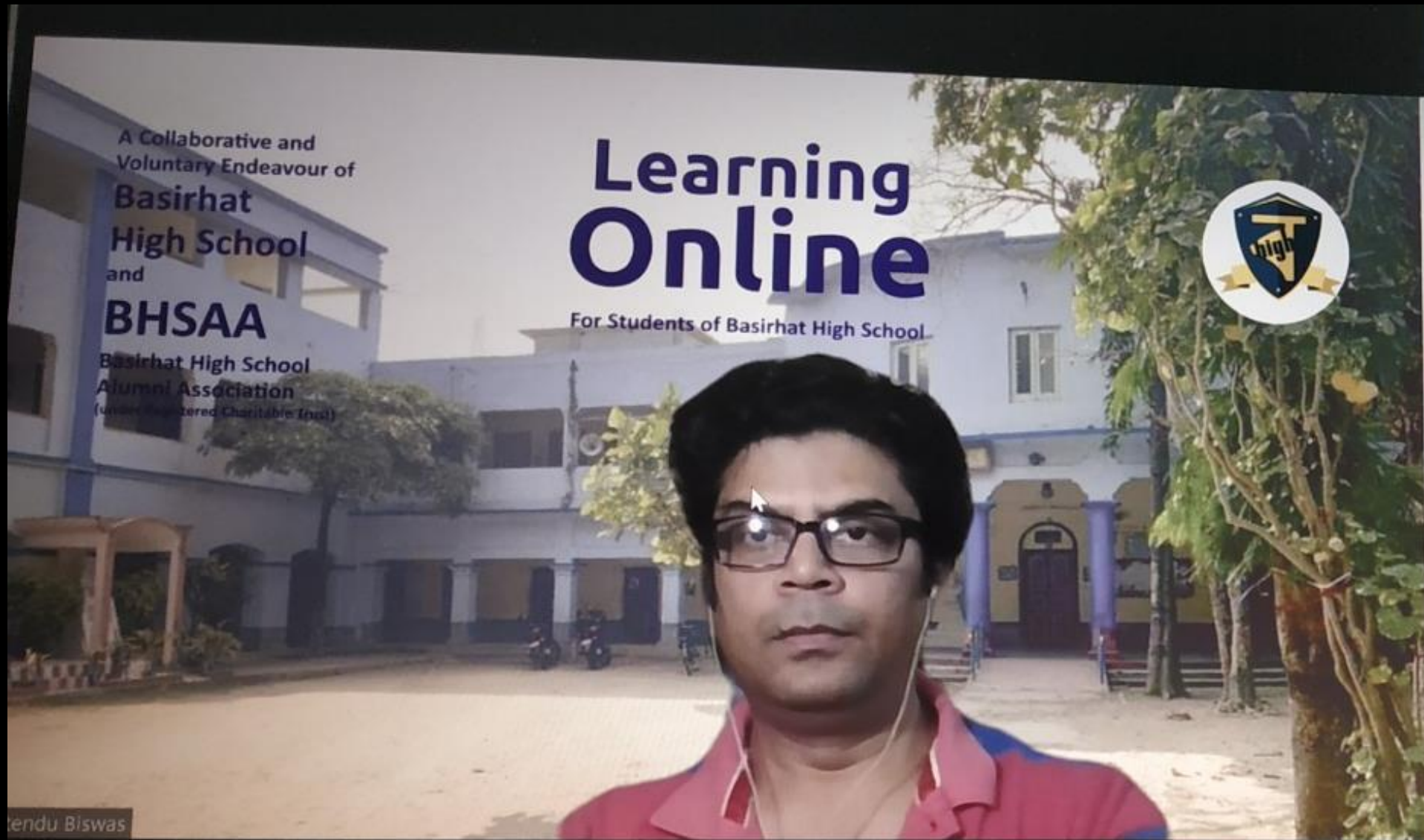

HOW TO MAKE ZOOM APP SECURE ?

- ❖ PASSWORD PROTECT YOUR MEETINGS
- ❖ AUTHENTICATE USERS
- ❖ JOIN BEFORE HOST
- ❖ LOCK DOWN YOUR MEETING
- ❖ TURN OFF PARTICIPANT SCREEN SHARING
- ❖ USE A RANDOMLY-GENERATED ID
- ❖ USE WAITING ROOMS
- ❖ AVOID FILE SHARING
- ❖ REMOVE NUISANCE ATTENDEES



HOUSEKEEPING NORMS TO CONTROL ENTRIES AND CONDUCT OF STUDENTS IN THE CLASS DURING LECTURES AND Q&A

Rules for discussion

1. Listen actively and attentively.
2. Ask for clarification if you are confused.
3. Do not interrupt one another.
4. Challenge one another, but do so respectfully. o Critique ideas, not people.

Rules for lectures

1. Arrive on time.
2. Turn your cell phone off.
3. Use laptops only for legitimate class activities (note-taking, assigned tasks).
4. Do not leave class early without okaying it with the instructor in advance.
5. Ask questions if you are confused. o Try not to distract or annoy your classmates

HOW TO DO TEAM TEACHING ?

Lock the virtual classroom

- To give instructors more control over what students are seeing and prevent them from sharing random content. Go to default screen-sharing settings for our education users. Sharing privileges are now set to "Host Only," so teachers by default are the only ones who can share content in class.

Enable the Waiting Room

- All Participants will send everyone to the virtual waiting area, where you can admit them individually or all at once.
- Guest Participants Only allows known students to skip the Waiting Room and join but sends anyone not signed in/part of your school into the virtual waiting area.

Lock down the chat

- Teachers can restrict the in-class chat so students cannot privately message other students. We'd recommend controlling chat access in your in-meeting toolbar controls (rather than disabling it altogether) so students can still interact with the teacher as needed.
